

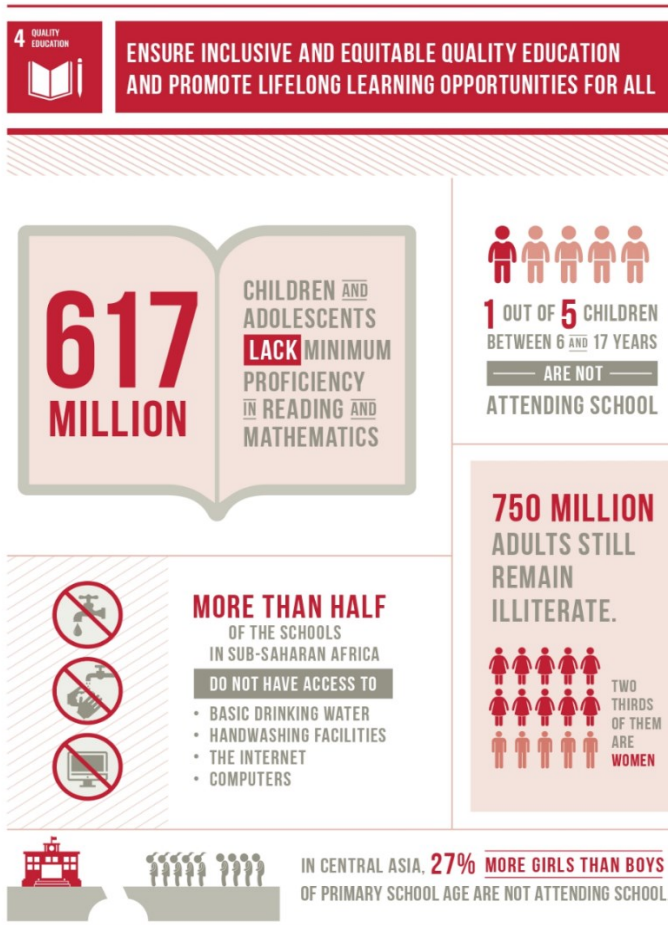

On-Screen Violence

Teenagers are going to witness some violent media at one time or another. And it's not just TV, music, and movies that depict violence. Many of today's violent video games portray gory scenes and disturbing acts of aggression. Over the past couple of decades, studies have linked these violent images to a lack of empathy and even aggressive behaviour. Other studies have shown the number one factor in determining how kids relate to media is how their parents think and act. That means the more violence parents watch, the more likely they are to think it's OK for their kids to view.

It is important for teens to check their media use. Do not watch R-rated movies or to play M-rated video games. It's not healthy for teens to consume that material in excess and unsupervised. Also, talk to your parents about the dangers of being exposed to violent images and control your mental state. It is also important to talk about sexual situations and racial stereotypes that teens might see.

Teens need to learn how to identify what is good and what is bad about the media. It helps them become a healthier consumer when they can think objectively about what they are seeing online, in the movie theatre, or in a video game.
